DIDN'T SC and GA VOTE TO END DAYLIGHT SAVINGS? The states voted in 2020 to make daylight saving time permanent, which means the states would stop changing the clocks twice a year and would no longer have to endure darkness before dinner during the winter months. However, the law doesn't take effect until Congress votes to end the time changes. As you can now probably guess, the bill was sent to the House, but nothing has been done with it since March 2022.

# **Safety Challenge**

Spring cleaning your way to good housekeeping

On nearly every safety to-do list is to check for good housekeeping. Springtime is a great motivator to jumpstart your cleaning goals at your worksites and home. Try these tips to make sure your work and home stay tidy and neat so you can prevent unnecessary accidents and falls!

<u>Make a schedule</u>. Start with scoping out your work site or home and noticing what needs the most work. Where do you skip during routine cleaning? Make a list and create your plan for each area.

Always work top to bottom. Start from the ceiling down to force debris downward and keep you from having to re-clean your space. Save floors for last!

<u>Declutter</u>. Decluttering makes you more efficient and organized. Too much clutter has psychological influences. It signals to your brain that work isn't done. Studies show it adds to your stress level, so be generous with what you donate and throw away.

Don't forget walls and windows. People almost always clean their floors, but they typically forget about walls and windows. Not all dust settles on the floor and other surfaces. Just use a damp towel to wipe down walls and blinds (starting from the top). Remove and wipe down the window screens outside.

To make the most of your spring cleaning, focus on two areas 1) tasks that will make your life easier all year long and 2) deep cleaning often-forgot-about areas.
